



## REQUEST FOR U-PASS Opt-Out

Full time students at the Cranbrook Campus of College of the Rockies (that pay Students' Association fees) are automatically assessed the U-Pass fee. The College of the Rockies, Students' Association and BC Transit have agreed to allow students to opt out of the U-Pass for the following reasons:

### 5.3 Opt-Out Criteria and Process

- a. A student assessed the U-Pass fee who:
  - i. may be eligible for an "Opt-Out" if the student meets eligibility requirements as per Article 5.3.b, or
  - ii. believes that they have circumstances which might make them eligible to Opt-Out, shall submit an appeal within 30 days of the start of his/her classes.
  
- b. Opt-Out" Eligibility:

The following students may be eligible to opt out of the U-Pass program:

  - i. Students with disabilities who can demonstrate their need to commute to/from the College by automobile other than the Cranbrook Transit fixed route or the handyDart services.
  - ii. Students in receipt of the annual CNIB Pass or the annual "BC Bus Pass" issued by the BC Government under social assistance programs.
